

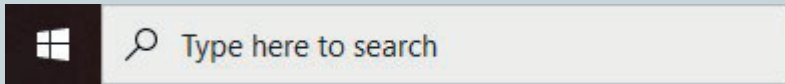

HDD ways to format

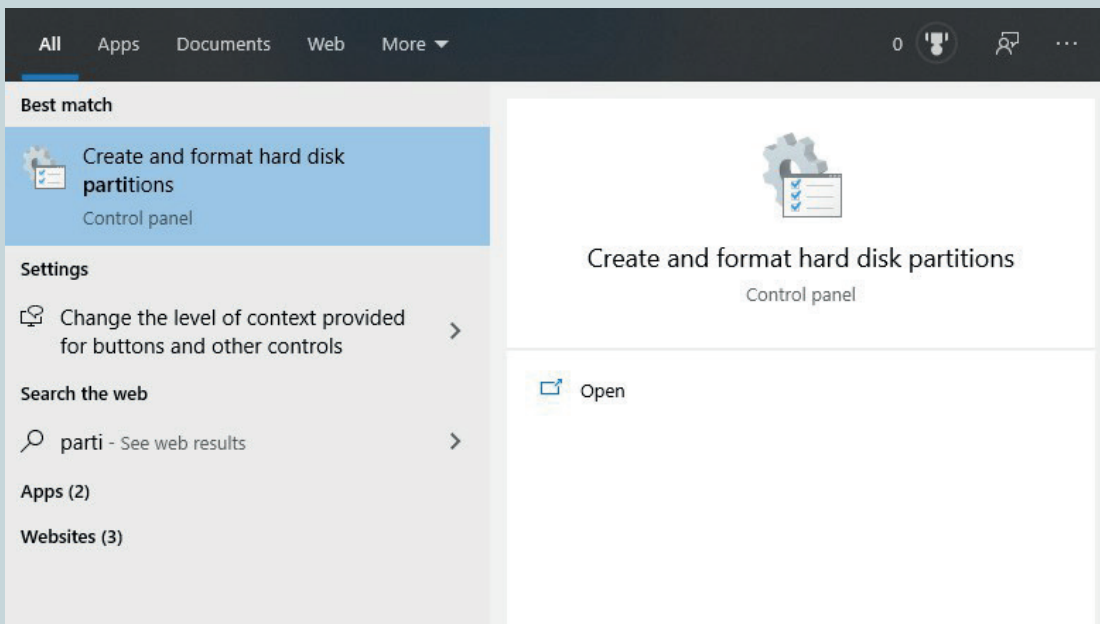
“The best choice in memory & data storage solutions”

How to format your Hard Disk Drive with the chance of getting your data back or without getting your data back:

- Click with your left mouse button on the windows search bar:



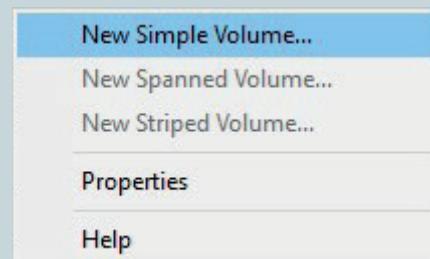
- then type "parti" and click the highlighted button:



- Make sure your hard drive has a volume. If you have a volume on your hard drive continue at B.

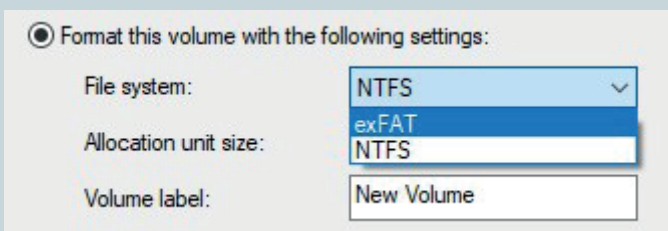
A. creating a volume

- Right click the storage bar of the hard drive and click:



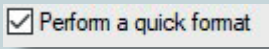
- Click next twice.

- Here you can assign a driver letter, then click next.



- From here you can directly format your disk to any format. (for example: FAT32, exFAT or NTFS)

- You can give the disk a name and choose if you want to quick format (with the possibility of getting your data back) or you turn of quick format. (the data can not be recovered)

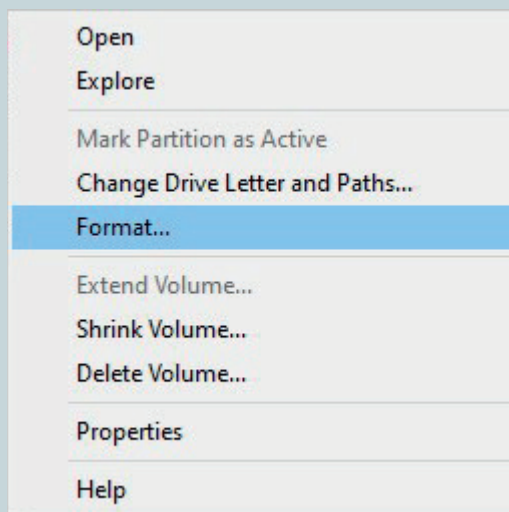


(BE AWARE! THIS PROCES CAN TAKE A LONG TIME!)

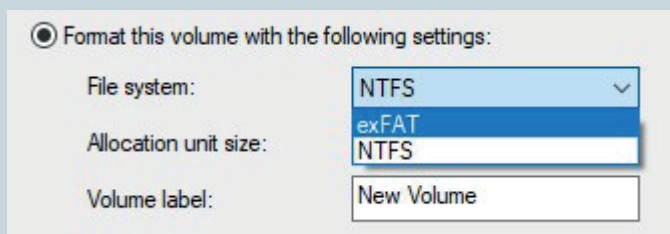
-Then click "next" --> "finish" and wait untill the format is done.

B. Formatting a existing volume

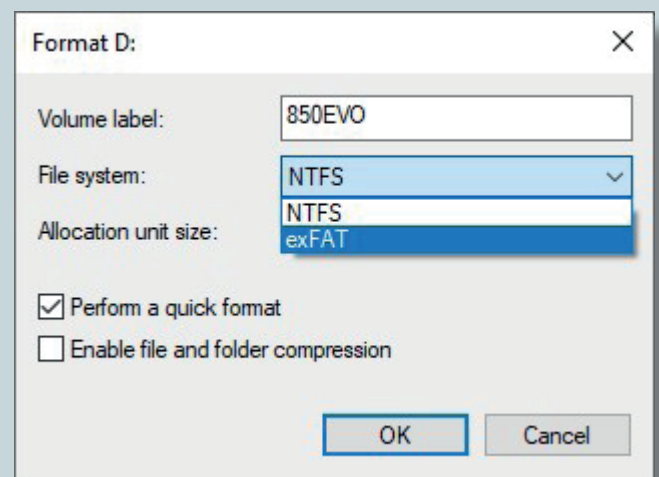
- Right click the storage bar of the hard drive:



- Here you can choose the file system (FAT32, exFAT of NTFS), give your drive a new name and choose if the disk gets a quick format (with possibility of data recovery) or turn off quick format. (data cant be recovered)



(BE AWARE! THIS PROCES CAN TAKE A LONG TIME!)



- Press ok once and read the tekst properly, and when you agree click ok again.
